## **Garden Hopscotch**

Quilt Finished Size: 82" x 100"

Block Finished Size: 9" (horizontal) x 7" (vertical)

Binding: 3/4y of 100-37 Brick, cut into 2 1/4" strips, and pieced to make a continuous binding strip

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Fabrics and Cutting Directions (note: all FQ's in the four panels except for the Petit Four white is used)





White tonal (100 Zinc) 3 3/8y			Cut for: a. pieced blocks (18) 2 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (280) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. b. sashing rectangles (3) 7 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (66) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles. c. horizontal sashing strips (20) 1 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (70) 9 ½" rectangles and (60) 1 1 ½" squares. Having the extra seams will help in keeping the blocks aligned. d. inner border (8) 2 1/2" x WOF. Piece strips and sub-cut (2) 2 1/2" x 73 1/2" and (2) 2 1/2" x 87 1/2" strips.
Black tonal (160 Zebra) 1/4y			Cut for pieced blocks: (2) 2 1/2" x WOF. Sub-cut (28) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.
White focal print (Q4443 White 1 1/2y)		2y)	Cut for outer border: (9) 5" x WOF. Piece strips and sub-cut (2) 5" x 82 1/2" and (2) 5" x 91 1/2" strips.


#### **Constructing Pieced Blocks**

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$  x  $2 \frac{1}{2}$  white tonal square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 4" x 5" <print> square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal white tonal corner triangle.


Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" <print> square. Place square, right sides together, at the corner of the white tonal corner triangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal <print> corner triangle to complete (1) sub-unit. Make a total of (2) sub-units.



Repeat to make (2) mirror-imaged sub-units.



Sew sub-units together to complete (1) pieced block.



2. Refer to fabric and cutting chart to make a total number of blocks for all the listed <prints>.


### **Quilt Center Assembly**

1. Pieced rows. Arrange and sew together (7) pieced blocks and (6)  $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 7 \frac{1}{2}$  white tonal sashing rectangles to make a pieced row. Refer to quilt center diagram for fabric placement guide. Make a total of (11) pieced rows.



2. Sew (6) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square white solid cornerstones and (7) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 9 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangles. Make 10 horizontal sashing rows.


3. Sew together (11) pieced rows and (10) 1 1/2" x 69 1/2" white tonal sashing strips to complete quilt center.



#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

1. Inner border. Sew (2) 2 1/2" x 87 1/2" white tonal strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 2 1/2" x 73 1/2" white tonal strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.

2. Outer border. Sew (2) 5" x 91 1/2" focal print strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 5" x 82 1/2" focal print strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



Quilting Instructions:

1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich.

- 2. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Bind to finish quilt.
