


# Near and Deer

## Near and Deer Table Runner

#### Fabric requirements:

12 Near and Deer fat eighths (9" by 20" approx.) 4 tan, 4 black and 4 gray.

½ yard Hoffman Watercolor (Style# 1895 494-Raven) for sashing and binding.

#### Cutting Instructions:

From each of the Near and Deer fat eighths cut a 6 inch strip. Sub cut into 1 - 6 inch square,  $2 - 3 \times 6$  inch rectangles, and 1 - 3 inch square.

From the Raven cut a 9 inch by WOF (width of fabric) strip. Sub cut into  $24 - 1 \times 9$  inch rectangles. Keep 12 of these 1 x 9 rectangles, and sub cut the remaining 12 into  $12 - 1 \times 6$  inch and  $12 - 1 \times 3$  inch rectangles. These rectangles will be used for sashing in the Near and Deer blocks. The remaining Raven will be used for binding. You will be able to cut  $3 - 2 \frac{1}{4}$  inch by WOF strips from the additional piece. Also needed, will be a  $2 \frac{1}{4}$  inch strip from the 9 inch piece used for sashing.

#### Block construction:

There are 4 Near and Deer Fabrics joined to make a block but only 3 different colors. Therefore, a color will be used more than once. Try to be as random as possible with your fabrics within a block. ¼ inch seam allowances used.

Sew a 3 x 6 inch Near and Deer rectangle (along the 3 inch side) to a 1 x 3 inch Raven sashing strip. Then join a 3 inch square of a different fabric to the other side of the Raven sashing.

Sew a 6 inch square to a 1 x 6 inch rectangle of Raven sashing and then sew a  $3 \times 6$  inch rectangle to the other side of the Raven sashing strip.

Press seam allowances towards the Raven sashing strip.

Finally join the two segments made with a  $1 \times 9$  inch sashing rectangle between them. The 3 and 6 inch sashing strips should be aligned to give the impression of an offset cross on the block.

Press the seam allowances towards the 1 x 9 Raven sashing piece.

### Table Runner Construction:

Arrange the blocks into a 2 by 6 block setting. Make sure that the Raven sashing units do not connect from block to block. Once arranged, sew the blocks together. Quilt and bind!
